East vs. South - Game 2 (Saturday, 7/21)

East Team evened the series as they beat South Team in another cardiac game, 65-61. South led much of the game and was leading 36-29 at half-time. They led as much as 7 points going into the last minute of the game, when a series of blunders allowed East to tie the score to 61 with a three point shot by Lablab Gresos (MVP of the game). Two free throws later by Abe Calub put East ahead by 2 points 20 seconds going into the game, and a game tying layup by Joseph Quebral missed. Abe was fouled and sealed the game with 2 free throws. East was led by Fred Calub with 24 points and Abe Calub (14 points) . South was led by big (and long) man William Stepelis with season high 24 points and Jerome Feliciano with 17 points. Both teams played with 5 players each with no substitution under the searing heat. Fred Calub fouled out, while 6 players from both teams had four fouls

Final deciding game in the best of three series lived up to its expectations and did not disappoint nonpaying fans and officials.
